The Elective Program Teacher will work with a group of students, grouped by age ranges ▪ Follow a one hour block routine to teach up to 4 electives per day ▪ The teacher will facilitate elective classes through a combination of teacher-led, child-led and group based lessons and activities ▪ Implementation of classes will take a whole child approach and engage children in exciting, creative, and hands-on activities that allow children to explore elective subjects in a unique and meaningful way ▪ Activities will have an emphasis on critical thinking and allow for individualization and adaptation to various learning styles ▪ The teacher will plan for daily make and take activities that show case concepts learned

The Elective Program Teacher will exhibit an educational philosophy and utilize teaching strategies that ▪ Teach problem solving and critical thinking skills by supporting the social and emotional development of each child ▪ Follows a positive discipline approach with children and is open to learning more about and implementing Non-Violent Communication methods ▪ Allow students to move around the room, interact with each other on the floor, and make decisions together ▪ Exhibits the ability and knowledge to work with students at various levels ▪ Displays ability to enrich activities and lessons with hands-on learning and out-of-the-box creativity ▪ Articulates a strong understanding of concept development and is able to incorporate skills and concepts in a natural way ▪ Utilizes lunch and outdoor exploration time as an extension of the learning environment and helps children strengthen social, physical, and intellectual development.

The Elective Program Teacher will play a vital role of the DOL team having the ability to ▪ Produce high quality work, competing tasks accurately and efficiently ▪ Displays excellent work habits of dependability, initiative, professionalism, organization and flexibility ▪ Can work well with others and utilize sound decision making skills in a fast paced environment ▪ Manages the classroom and tasks with attention to detail, seeing the big picture and setting goals accordingly ▪ Plans elective lessons, requests and maintains supplies to provide a quality elective program ▪ Takes pride in caring for classroom and respectful of sharing space with other teachers and facilities ▪ Assist in communicating and providing suggestions/resources and works collaboratively with the whole family ▪ Uses effective communication with students, staff and families both verbally and in writing
